

## More Than 1,000 Fairgoers Vaccinated at Minnesota State Fair

Today, Governor Tim Walz announced that more than 1,000 Fairgoers have been vaccinated at the COVID-19 Community Vaccination Clinic at the Minnesota State Fair.

**“More than 1,000 Fairgoers have rolled up their sleeves and walked away with both \$100 in hand and a new layer of protection against this deadly virus,”** said Governor Walz. **“Don’t miss this opportunity. If you’re already going to be at the State Fair, get your shot and get your cash.”**

So far, 1,199 Fairgoers have received a COVID-19 vaccine at the Community Vaccine Clinic. Minnesotans who get their first dose at the clinic can receive a \$100 Visa gift card on site. Of the 3,600 gift cards available, Fairgoers have claimed 1,183.

**“I’m grateful so many Fairgoers are taking this opportunity to get protected against COVID-19,”** said Lieutenant Governor Peggy Flanagan. **“More than 1,000 more Minnesotans are now vaccinated thanks to this Community Vaccine Clinic. Let’s keep it going Fairgoers — and get your \$100!”**

In just over four days, the Minnesota State Fair has administered more vaccines than other state fairs around the Midwest. The Community Vaccine Clinic will be open daily 9 a.m. to 9 p.m., and 9 a.m. to 8 p.m. on Labor Day. State Fair tickets are required to enter State Fairgrounds.
